

**ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN MISC. APPLICATION NO.66 OF 2026
IN MACP NO.2193 OF 2011**

1. Claimant in MACP No.2193 of 2011 named Dilip Dattaram Dalvi died leaving behind him his wife Mrs. Neeta Dilip Dalvi and a son named Apurva Dilip Daliv and a daughter named Mrs. Gauri Amey Naiksatam.
2. Now by this application, the wife of original claimant, daughter and son have prayed to recall the amount standing in the name of deceased claimant and which was transferred in Unclaimed amount, and further disbursed the same to the wife of the deceased i.e. Mrs. Neeta Dilip Dalvi including their shares. In this way, son and daughter of the deceased relinquished their shares in the share of their mother Mrs. Neeta Dilip Dalvi and filed affidavits Exh.3 and Exh.4 respectively.
3. Report of the Accounts Officer dt. 16.02.2026 and Writ Section dt. 26.02.2026 indicate that Bharti Axa General Insurance Co. Ltd. has deposited cheque for Rs.95,978/- in the Tribunal on 24.08.2020 which was invested in Canara Bank, Fort Market Branch, Mumbai on 20.10.2022. There is no order received from the Hon'ble High Court regarding this matter.
4. Since the daughter and son of the deceased submitted affidavits having no objection to disburse the entire amount in the name of their mother- wife of the deceased Dilip Dalvi, following order is passed:

ORDER

- 1 Misc. Application No.66 of 2026 is allowed.
- 2 An amount of Rs.95,978/- lying in the name of deceased claimant Dilip Dattaram Dalvi along with

the interest accrued thereon be recalled and transferred in the Bank Account of Mrs. Neeta Dilip Dalvi only after her providing the copies of her account and bank details, through NEFT/RTGS on verifying her identity and the proof thereof.
