

ORDER BELOW EXH.1

This is an application for withdrawal of Award sum.

2. Perused the application. Heard.
3. The claim-application of the applicant was disposed of by Judgment and Award dated 12.09.2007 granting compensation of Rs.7,07,061/- **with interest**, on account of death caused in motor vehicular accident.
4. Aggrieved thereby the said Judgment and Award, the MSRTC had approached the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in First Appeal No. 1185 of 2008 which came to be dismissed on 07.09.2022. The report of Writ Section, M.A.C.T., Mumbai dated 18.03.2026 does not reveal any further appeal preferred against the same or any stay order received pertaining to the present matter.
5. The report of Accounts Officer, M.A.C.T., Mumbai shows that the MSRTC has deposited cheque of Rs.7,07,061/- in the name of A.O., M.A.C.T., Mumbai on 13.07.2023, which came to be invested in the Bank of Maharashtra, Girgaon Branch, Mumbai, in the name of the A.O., M.A.C.T., Mumbai, on 24.08.2023.
6. In view of above, the applicant is entitled to withdraw the Award sum alongwith interest. Hence, the following order,

## ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The Accounts Officer, M.A.C.T., Mumbai is directed to recall the Award sum of Rs.7,07,061/- invested in the name of A.O., M.A.C.T., Mumbai, alongwith accrued interest and transfer the same in the bank account of the applicant through NEFT/RTGS, as per rules, on proper verification, after furnishing her necessary details by applicant as follows -
  - a) Name and address,
  - b) Name of Bank and Branch,
  - c) Bank Account Number,
  - d) Bank IFSC code,
  - e) Copy of first page of bank passbook containing photograph of the applicant duly attested by the concerned bank,
  - f) Self attested copy of Aadhar card and PAN card.
3. Any other application, if pending, stands disposed of.
