

**Order below Exh.1 in MA 165 of 2026
In MACP No.1075 of 2020**

1. Advocate of the applicants have filed application for disbursement of balance award amount. Report of the Account officer and Clerk (Writ Department) was called for. Account officer has given report that the balance amount of Rs.30,87,920/- is invested in Bank of Maharashtra, Girgaon Branch, Mumbai vide C. No.1098/23 and 63/24. Clerk (Writ Department) has given report that there is no stay in the matter by the Hon'ble High Court or Hon'ble Supreme Court.

2. Perused record. By order dated 13/12/2025 Hon'ble High Court has disposed off First Appeal No.789/2023 as per the consent terms and conditions of the parties. As per the consent terms the amount of Rs.4,34,854/- is waived off. As there is no stay for disbursement of balance award amount, in view of the consent terms filed by the parties before the Hon'ble High Court, the applicants are allowed to withdraw the same. Hence, the order-

ORDER

- (i) The application is allowed.
- (ii) Accounts officer to disburse 40% of Rs.26,53,066/- to applicant no.1 Anis Rafiq Shaikh and 20% of Rs.26,53,066/- each to the applicant no.2 to no.4 i.e. Irshad Mohammad Anis Shaik, Reshama Anis Shaik and Mohammad Dilsad Mohd. Anis Shaik respectively alongwith accrued interest thereon by NEFT/RTGS.
- (iii) Issue letter to Branch Manager, Bank of Maharashtra, Girgaon Branch, Mumbai, accordingly.
