AWARD

The dispute between the parties having been referred for determination to Lok Adalat and parties having compromised / settled the case/matter, the following award is passed in terms of settlement.

The Applicants and their Advocate present, the officer of Insurance Company **Mr.Sourin Saha** /Advocate **Seema Karkera** duly authorized by the Insurer to settle the matter and sign the award is present.

The Applicants and Insurer amicably settled the claim for **Rs.11,00,000/- (Rs.Eleven Lakhs Only)** as full and final settlement, the Insurer agreed to deposit the settlement / awarded amount within a month from the date of award. The Applicants submitted that the matter is settled without any force or coercion. The Applicants are duly identified by **Adv.Brahmanand R.Nishad.**

Considering the terms between the parties the Insurer is directed to deposit the settlement award amount in the Tribunal within a month from the date of this award, failing of which, same shall carry the interest @ 7% p.a. from the date of this award till its realization.

The apportionment of the awarded amount would be as under:

2. The applicant No.2 01,00,000/-
3. The applicant No.3 Nil
4. The applicant No.4


The Account officer is directed to pay amount of compensation as per abovementioned apportionment to the Applicants and share of Applicant Nos. 2 & may be invested till he/she attains the age of majority in nationalized bank. The amount of compensation be paid through NEFT/RTGS in their nationalized bank A/C to the Applicants.

The parties are informed that the court fee, if any, paid by any of them shall be refunded.
