AWARD

The dispute between the parties having been referred for determination to Lok Adalat and parties having compromised / settled the case/matter, the following award is passed in terms of settlement.

The Applicants and their Advocate present, the advocate for Royal Sundaram Gen. Insurance Company Smt. Sakshi Jadhav duly authorized by the Insurer to settle the matter and sign the award is present.

The Applicants and Insurer amicably settled the claim for Rs.21,50,000/- as full and final settlement, including NFL the Insurer agreed to deposit the settlement / awarded amount within a month from the date of award. The Applicants submitted that the matter is settled without any force or coercion. The Applicants are duly identified by Adv. Shri. U. N. Mehta.

Considering the terms between the parties the Insurer is directed to deposit the settlement award amount in the Tribunal within a month from the date of this award, failing of which, same shall carry the interest @ 7% p.a. from the date of this award till its realization.

The applicant No.1, 4, 5 are brothers, applicant Nos.2 and 3 are parents, applicant No.6 is sister whereas applicant No.7 is the minor daughter of the deceased Pujita Kate @ Pawar. All applicants are present. They submitted that the entire amount of compensation shall be invested in the name of minor applicant No.7 namely Kum. Vidhi Pawar. The next friend of the minor applicant filed an affidavit which is also signed by Adv. Shri. U. N. Mehta stating that the settlement is in the interest of minor applicant. Therefore, entire amount of compensation shall be invested in the name of minor applicant No.7 in any Nationalized Bank till she attains the age of majority.

The parties are informed that the court fee, if any, paid by any of them shall be refunded.
