

ORDER BELOW EX.1 IN CLAIM PETITION NO.1811 OF 2019

The matter was referred for mediation. Perused the report of Mediator (Exh.31), Compromise Pursis (Exh.28) and Authority Letter (Exh.29) issued by the Insurer. The applicant and Insurer have settled the matter before the trained Judge Mediator, S.E. Bangar on 17.03.2026. Both the parties admitted the contents of Compromise Pursis (Exh.28) as true and correct. Hence, I pass the following Award:-

AWARD

- 1} The application is allowed in terms of settlement (Exh.28).
- 2} Claim is amicably settled for a full and final amount of Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lakh Only). The Insurer shall pay aforesaid amount **to the next friend of the claimant** within 6 weeks from the date of this order, failing which the Insurer shall pay interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of order till realization.
- 3} Insurer is directed to deposit the awarded amount to the credit of the bank account of this Tribunal directly by NEFT/RTGS. The details of the bank account of this Tribunal are as under:-
