

**Order Below Exh.6 in Execution Application No.337/ 2023**

**In**

**Disposed MACP No.2204 of 1999**

By this application the applicants have prayed that they be permitted to withdraw the amount of compensation as per the judgment order Dt.18.8.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in First Appeal No.2363 of 2005.

The report of the A.O. shows that the New India Ass. Co.Ltd. has deposited cheque for Rs.62,63,121/- in the name of A.O., MACT, Mumbai on 18.03.2024 and this amount is invested in Canara bank, A.R.Street Branch, Mumbai on 08.11.2023. While the reports of writ section show that there is no other order than the order Dt.18.8.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in First Appeal No.2363/2005 and further there is no any order from the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter till today.

As per the order Dt.18.8.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in First Appeal No.2363/2005, the present applicants have been permitted to withdraw the entire amount alongwith interest accrued thereon. Thus, the applicants are entitled to withdraw the amount as per the said order. Hence, this application deserves to be allowed. Hence, I pass the following order.

1. The execution application is allowed.

2. The Accounts Officer is directed to recall the said amount along-with interest accrued thereon from Bank, to the credit of the bank account of this Tribunal. The details of the bank account of this Tribunal are as under:-
