ORDER BELOW EXH. NO. 01

(Passed on 18.06.2026)

The present application is for grant of Legal Heir Certificate U/Sec. 2 of the Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827, Act. The applicants are claiming Legal Heir Certificate as being legal heirs of deceased **Mojya Divala Bhil**.

2] It is submitted by the applicants that:-

Applicant No. 1 to 4 are sons and Applicant No. 5 is daughter of deceased **Mojya Divala Bhil** who died on 15.04.2021 at Tembhurni, Po. Mandavi Bu., Tal Akrani/Dhadgaon, Dist. Nandurbar. Father of deceased **Divala Singa Bhil** was died on 06.07.2011, wife of deceased **Suribai Mojya Bhil** was died 14 yrs. ago and mother of deceased **Yutibai Divala Bhil** was died 32 yrs ago. As there are no legal heirs to the deceased than the applicants, they have filed present application for getting the Heir-ship Certificate for mutating their names in revenue records and other related official purpose.

3] Paper publication and citation notice was issued for calling upon objection from the public at large. Accordingly, citation notice was issued to the Grampanchayat and Tahsildar. Its copies are placed on record respectively at Exh. 6 and 7. The paper publication was also issued in daily news paper 'Dainik Varta' dated 14.02.2026 and its copy placed at Exh. 23. However, no one turned up till today to contest the instant application.

4] Applicants have applied for Heir-ship Certificate. It is needless to say that, no rights would be conferred to the person in whose favor Heirship Certificate would have been issued. The granting of said heir-ship certificate shall not finally determine or injure the rights of any person. The Heir-ship Certificate is meant for only time being management of the property.

5] In support of their contention, the applicants have examined Applicant No. 1 **Raysing @ Rasha Moja Valvi** and filed his evidence on affidavit

at Exh. 10. So also evidence on affidavit of one **Vankar Fulya Valvi**, R/o. **Tembhurni, Po. Mandavi Bu.** adduced by the applicants at Exh. 11. The affidavits are consistent with the contents of the application. Apart from the oral evidence, applicants have produced documentary evidence on record i.e., Death Certificate of deceased **Mojya Divalya Bhil** and **Divala Singa Bhil** at Exh. 14 & 21 respectively, copies of Aadhaar Cards of Applicant No. 1 to 5 at Exh. 15 to 19 respectively, Copy of bank passbook of deceased **Moja** at Exh. 20, Non leaving certificate of deceased **Suribai Mojya Bhil** and **Yutibai Divala Bhil** at Exh. 22 & 25 respectively, Succession report of deceased by Sarpanch/Police Patil at Exh. 24. The applicants have closed their evidence purshis Exh. 27. Till today, nobody has resisted the present claim of the applicants and came in the court to claim the heir-ship certificate. The evidence brought on record shows that the Applicants are the only legal heirs of deceased and there are no other legal heir to the deceased **Mojya Divala Bhil** other than the applicants.

6] Considering all the above aspects, and after hearing Learned Advocate C. D. Valvi for Applicants, I do not find any legal impediment in allowing the present application. Hence order-

ORDER

1]	The application is allowed.
2]	Issue Heirship Certificate in the name of the Applicant No. 1 Raysing @ Rasha Mojya Valvi , Applicant No. 2 Ashok Mojya Bhil Applicant No. 3 Dhursing Mojya Valvi , Applicant No. 4 Pintu Mojya Bhil and Applicant No. 5 Lila Ramakant Pawara being the legal heirs of deceased Mojya Divalya Bhil as per the provisions under Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 for mutating their names in revenue records and other related official purpose. The Applicants are directed to file the affidavit of the value of the benefits which they would receive by using the Legal Heirs Certificate and to furnish the Indemnity Bonds in the like amount.
