ORDER BELOW EXH. NO. 01

(Passed on 16.06.2026)

The present application is for grant of Legal Heir Certificate U/Sec. 2 of the Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827, Act. The applicants are claiming Legal Heir Certificate as being legal heirs of deceased **Parsha Devaji Pawara**.

2] It is submitted by the applicants that:-

Applicant No. 3 is son, Applicant No. 5 is wife and Applicant No. 6 is daughter and Applicant No. 1 to 3 are legal heirs of deceased son of Late **Pratap Parasha Pawara** of deceased **Parasha Devaji Pawara** who died on 28.12.2017 at Somane, Tal Akrani/Dhadgaon, Dist. Nandurbar. Mother of deceased **Teparibai Devaji Pawara** was died was died 30 yrs. ago and son of deceased **Pratap Parasha Pawara** was died on 28.12.2024. As there are no legal heirs to the deceased than the applicants, they have filed present application for getting the Heir-ship Certificate for Government and Semi Government purpose and other related official purpose.

3] Paper publication and citation notice was issued for calling upon objection from the public at large. Accordingly, citation notice was issued to the Grampanchayat and Tahsildar. Its copies are placed on record respectively at Exh. 6 and 7. The paper publication was also issued in daily news paper 'Nanddarshan' dated 12.03.2026 and its copy placed at Exh. 20. However, no one turned up till today to contest the instant application.

4] Applicants have applied for Heir-ship Certificate. It is needless to say that, no rights would be conferred to the person in whose favor Heirship Certificate would have been issued. The granting of said heir-ship certificate shall not finally determine or injure the rights of any person. The Heir-ship Certificate is meant for only time being management of the property.

5] In support of their contention, the applicants have examined Applicant No. 1 **Mogendra Pratap Pawara** and filed his evidence on affidavit at Exh. 10. So also evidence on affidavit of one **Mersing Motya Pawara**, R/o. **Somane** adduced by the applicants at Exh. 11. The affidavits are consistent with the contents of the application. Apart from the oral evidence, applicants have produced documentary evidence on record i. e., Death Certificate of deceased **Pratap Parashi Pawara** and **Parasha Devaji Pawara** at Exh. 12 & 13 respectively, copies of Aadhar Cards of applicant no. 1 to 6 at Exh. 14 to 19 respectively, Succession report of deceased by Sarpanch/Police Patil at Exh. 21., 'Non leaving certificate' of the deceased **Teparibai Devaji Pawara** at Exh. 22, Namuna No. 8 in the name of deceased **Parasha Devaji Pawara** at Exh. 23. The applicants have closed their evidence pursuant to Exh. 25. Till today, nobody has resisted the present claim of the applicants and come in the court to claim the heir-ship certificate. The evidence brought on record shows that the Applicant Nos. 4 to 6 and deceased son late **Pratap Parasha Pawara** are the only legal heirs of deceased and there are no other legal heir to the deceased **Parasha Devaji Pawara** other than the applicants

6] Considering all the above aspects, and after hearing Learned Advocate M. Z. Padvi for Applicants, I do not find any legal impediment in allowing the present application. Hence order-

ORDER

1]	The application is allowed.
2]	Issue Heirship Certificate in the name of deceased son Pratap Parasha Pawara , Applicant No. 4 Palya Parsha Pawara , Applicant No. 5 Sayadi Parasha Pawara and Applicant No. 6 Kamali Shildar Pawara being the legal heirs of deceased Parasha Devaji Pawara as per the provisions under Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 for mutating their names in revenue records and other related official purpose. The Applicant Nos. 4 to 6 and deceased son late Pratap Parasha Pawara (Applicant No. 1 to 3) are directed to file the affidavit of the value of the benefits which they would receive by using the Legal Heirs Certificate and to furnish the Indemnity Bonds in the like amount.
