

ORDER BELOW EXH. 5 In R.C.S. No. 25/2018

1. Perused the application. Plaintiffs have filed suit for declaration of ownership and permanent injunction restraining defendants from interfering possession of plaintiffs over suit land bearing Gut No. 31/2 admeasuring 4H 13 R, situated at village Devalipada, Tal. Navapur, Dist. Nandurbar belonging to plaintiffs. They have filed application at Exh. 5 mentioning that they are in possession of suit property since 40 years and defendants threatened to dispossess them on 20/05/2018. Hence, order of status quo may be granted in their favour during pendency of suit.

2. Heard learned advocate for plaintiffs and perused record. They have requested for ex-parte ad-interim injunction till disposal of application at Exh. 5. According to me, it will just and proper to give opportunity to defendants to file say if any before passing order of temporary injunction. Hence, I pass following order in the interest of justice.

ORDER

- 1) Issue notice to defendants to show cause why ex-parte injunction should not be granted against them within 2 days from service of notice to them.
- 2) E.P. and S.B. allowed.
