ORDER BELOW EXH-01 IN CIVIL M.A. NO.172/2025
(Passed on 06.05.2026)

This is an application for grant of heirship certificate u/s. 2 & 3 of Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827.

2) The applicant has contended that, he is the heir of deceased **Gorkha Kevaji Bhilav** who died on **08.07.2024** at Karade, Tal. Taloda, Dist. Nandurbar. The wife of deceased is also died. The applicants have contended that, the applicant is the sons of deceased **Gorkha Kevaji Bhilav**. The applicant requires the heirship certificate for the Government and semi Government purpose. Applicant submitted that, he is the heirs of the deceased **Gorkha Kevaji Bhilav**. There are no heirs other than him. So, he prayed for allowing an application and issuing heirship certificate in his name.

3) After filing of this application, public notice was issued in the daily Newspaper "**Nanddarshan**" at Exh.12 dated 11.09.2025 and objections were called, if any. Till today nobody has filed any objection to issue the heirship certificate of the deceased in the name of the applicant.

4) In support of this application, applicant has adduced the evidence by way of affidavit vide Exh.22 before the Court. In his evidence affidavit, he has reiterated the same facts as per contentions of an application. According to him, he is the heir of the deceased **Gorkha Kevaji Bhilav** . In support of

this application, he filed following documents on record :

5) The applicant filed evidence close pursis at Exh.19. The evidence adduced by the applicant remained unchallenged as nobody appeared and cross-examined to the applicant. The claim of the applicant for grant of heirship certificate has gone unchallenged. Moreover, the heirship certificate is merely a formal recognition that the applicant is the legal heir of the deceased. Therefore, I am inclined to issue heirship certificate by showing applicant as heir of the deceased **Gorkha Kevaji Bhilav** Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1.	Application is allowed.
2.	Issue heir-ship certificate in favour of the applicant showing him as legal heir of deceased Gorkha Kevaji Bhilav On deposit of court fees as per rule.
