**ORDER BELOW EXH-01 IN CIVIL M.A. NO.247/2025**  
**(Passed on 06.04.2026)**

This is an application for grant of heirship certificate u/s. 2 & 3 of Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827.

2) The applicant has contended that, she is the heir of deceased **Satibai Sonya Padvi** who died on 28.12.2018 at Taloda, Tal. Taloda, Dis.Nandurbar. The husband of the deceased also died. The applicant has contended that, she is the daughter of deceased **Satibai Sonya Padvi**. The applicant requires the heirship certificate for the Government and semi Government purpose. Applicant submitted that, she is the heir of the deceased **Satibai Sonya Padvi**. There are no heirs other than her. So, she prayed for allowing an application and issuing heirship certificate in her name.

3) After filing of this application, public notice was issued in the daily Newspaper "**Dainik Varta**" at Exh.16 dated 08.01.2026 and objections were called, if any. Till today nobody has filed any objection to issue the heirship certificate of the deceased in the name of the applicant.

4) In support of this application, applicant has adduced the evidence by way of affidavit vide Exh.15 before the Court. In her evidence affidavit, she has reiterated the same facts as per contentions of an application. According to her, she is the heir of the deceased **Satibai Sonya Padvi**. In support of this application, she filed following documents on record :

5) The applicant filed evidence close pursis at Exh.24. The evidence adduced by the applicant remained unchallenged as nobody appeared and cross-examined to the applicant. The claim of the applicant for grant of heirship certificate has gone unchallenged. Moreover, the heirship certificate is merely a formal recognition that the applicant is the legal heir of the deceased. Therefore, I am inclined to issue heirship certificate by showing applicant as heir of the deceased **Satibai Sonya Padvi.** Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

### **ORDER**

1.	Application is allowed.
2.	Issue heir-ship certificate in favour of the applicant showing her as legal heir of deceased <b>Satibai Sonya Padvi.</b> On deposit of court fees as per rule.
