	12.08.2026	1. Learned Counsel for the Prosecution and the Learned Counsel for the Defence are present. 2. Seen the Petition U/S 482 B.N.N.S., supported with affidavit, filed by accused person Rekibul Hoque who is apprehending arrest in connection with the Sipajhar P.S. Case No. 42 of 2026, incorporating, inter-alia, that no any bail petition is pending in any other Court and/or was rejected. 3. The case was registered under Section 140(3) of the B.N.S., 2023. 4. Heard Learned Counsel for both the sides. 5. Learned Counsel for the accused person has submitted that the accused person is innocent and he was not	

	12.08.2026	involved in commission of any offence. 6. Learned Counsel for the accused person has further submitted that accused person is arrayed in the instant case without any basis as the daughter of the informant and accused person have been in a love affair and as such she voluntarily went with the accused person. 7. Learned Counsel for the accused person has also submitted that the accused person is a local and law abiding and willing to co-operate and participate in investigation and prayed for allowing interim protection at this stage. 8. Per contra, Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State resisted the bail application praying for rejection. 9. Allegations, as per the F.I.R., inter-alia, is that the accused person/petitioner Rekibul Hoque had enticed and kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant which set the investigation in to motion. 10. Investigating Officer has produced the Case Diary and the same is	
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	12.08.2026	placed before the Court for consideration of bail prayer. 11. Upon perusal and consideration of the materials on Case Diary, it appears that the alleged victim girl was recovered and her statement was also recorded by the Learned Judicial Magistrate, Darrang, Mangaldai. 12. Taking note of the statement of the alleged victim recorded by the Learned Judicial Magistrate, Darrang, Mangaldai in the backdrop of progress of investigation, I am of the considered view that in the event the accused person/Petitioner extend co-operation in investigation, his custodial detention may not be required. 13. Accordingly, it is hereby provided that the accused person/Petitioner Rekibul Hoque shall surrender before the Investigating Officer within a fortnight of the passing of this order and in the event accused person/Petitioner above-named is arrested in connection with the present case, he shall be released on pre-arrest bail of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty	
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	12.08.2026	Thousand) with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer with following conditions: i). that the accused person shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when he is required for necessary investigation of the case for a period of next two months or filing of Final Form whichever is earlier; ii). that the accused person shall not hamper with the investigation, or tamper with the evidence collection process; iii). that the accused person shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer. 14. Send a copy of this order to the Investigating Officer along with returning the Case Diary in a sealed cover. 15. Instant case is disposed of accordingly.	Sessions Judge, Darrang, Mangaldai.
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
