:- ORDER :-

Apprehending his arrest in Crime No. 274 of 2026, registered with Ardhapur Police Station, for the offences under Sections for the offences under Section 329(3), 126(2), 296, 115(2), 74, 117(2), 351(2) and 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (in short 'BNS'), the applicant has filed present application for pre-arrest bail.

1. The applicant has filed present application for releasing him on bail in connection with Crime No. 274 of 2026, registered with Ardhapur Police Station, for the offences under Section 329(3), 126(2), 296, 115(2), 74, 117(2), 351(2) and 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (in short 'BNS').

2. Perused application and reply of Investigating Officer below Exh. 08.

3. Heard Learned advocate for the applicant and learned Addl. PP for the State.

4. FIR is lodged on 27-05-2026 alleging that applicant and co-accused trespassed in to the agricultural field of the family of the informant. They obstructed the agricultural activities, abused the family members of the informant, outraged modesty of the informant and assaulted her family members by fist and kick blows. During the assault, co-accused hit a bracelet causing grievous injury to the husband of the informant. Applicant and co-accused assaulted the other family members of the informant and caused injuries.

5. The Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that applicant is in service as police constable. There is delay in lodging FIR. The present FIR is counter blast to the FIR lodged by the brother of the applicant. The I.O has served notice upon the co-accused u/s. 35(3) of the BNSS. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant. Therefore, custodial interrogation of the applicant is not necessary.

6. On the other hand, the Ld. APP argued that FIR categorically states prima facie involvement and overt act of the applicant. The applicant has active participation in the offence. Therefore, his custodial interrogation is necessary.

7. Ld. Advocate for intervenor / informant filed Valakatnama but has failed to furnish written arguments as directed by the Court.

8. Perused the case papers.

9. As per FIR, the incident took place on 20-05-2026 at 5.30 pm. The informant has lodged FIR on 27-05-2026. Column No. 8 of the FIR states that delay in lodging FIR as the informant went to police station on 27-05-2026. It appears that the parties are having dispute over the agricultural field. The family of the applicant has lodged FIR on 21-05-2026 against male family members of the informant regarding the incident dated 20-05-2026. Therefore, the Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that present FIR is after thought counter blast to the FIR lodged by the brother of the applicant.

10. FIR demonstrates that major allegations are against accused No. 2. As per say of I.O the accused No.2 and other co-accused are released after serving notice u/s. 35(3) of the BNSS. Say of I.O further reflects that articles used in the offence are already seized from the co-accused. As such nothing more is to be recovered or seized. All the offences are punishable with imprisonment up to and less than 07 yearss. In these circumstances, the arrest and custodial

interrogation of the applicant may not be necessary. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. In the event of arrest, in crime No. 274/2026 registered with Ardhapur police station, Applicant **Revan @ Arjun Siddheshwar Swami**, be released on his executing P.R. Bond of **Rs.15,000/-** with one solvent surety in the like amount, on following conditions :-
 - a) Applicant shall attend the I.O on 04-07-2026 in between 10.00 am to 12.00 and thereafter whenever called by the I.O under written intimation till filing of charge-sheet or till 60 days from today whichever is earlier.
 - b) Applicant shall co-operate the investigation.
 - d) Applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and witnesses.
3. Informed the concern police station.
