1. The applicant has filed present application for releasing him on bail in connection with Crime No. 206 of 2026, registered with Ardhapur Police Station, for the offences under Section 74, 118(1), 296, 115(2), 351(2), 351(3), 189(2) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita (in short 'BNS) and Sections 3(1)(r) of the Scheduled Caste and

Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (in short 'SCST Act').

2. Perused application and reply of Investigating Officer below Exh. 09.

3. Heard Learned advocate for the applicants and learned Addl. PP for the State.

4. FIR is lodged on 19-04-2026 alleging that incident occurred on 18-04-2026. The accused beat and slapped the husband of the informant by abusing and giving caste related abuses. When the informant tried to intervene, the accused caught hold her hand and outraged her modesty. The accused caused injury to her husband and threatened to kill him.

5. The Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that there is delay in lodging the FIR. There is no allegation in the FIR against the present applicant. The investigation is complete and the charge-sheet is filed. Nothing is to be recovered from the present applicant. No purpose will be served by keeping him behind the bar. Therefore, applicant be released on bail on any terms and conditions.

6. On the other hand, the Ld. APP strongly opposed for grant of bail stating that the FIR and say of the I.O states specific role of the applicant. There is prima facie case against the applicant and co-accused who have outraged modesty of the informant. Therefore,

application is not entitled for bail.

7. The informant has filed her affidavit vide Exh. 10 and strongly opposed for grant of bail.

8. The incident is dated 18-04-2026. The present applicant is arrested on 02-06-2026. FIR does not name the applicant. From the say of the I.O, it appears that investigation is over and charge-sheet has been filed. The trial is not expected to commence and conclude in near future. Offences are not punishable with death penalty. No fruitful purpose will be served by detaining the applicant pending the trial. The grounds opposing bail can be addressed by imposing suitable conditions. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. Applicant **Ganraj Sanjay Patil** be released on his executing PR. Bond of **Rs.15,000/-** with one solvent surety in the like amount, on following conditions :-
 - a) Applicant shall attend the trial regularly unless exempted.
 - b) Applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and witnesses.
 - c) Applicant shall stay away and shall not contact the informant and her family members in any manner.
