ORDER

(Passed on 04.07.2026)

The applicant has filed present application for releasing him on regular bail in connection with Crime No.21 of 2025, registered with Shivajinagar Police Station, for the offences under Sections 109, 118(2), 115(2), 189(2), 191(2), 191(3), 190 of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, (in short 'BNS') along with Section 4/25 of Indian Arms Act.

2. Perused application and reply of Investigating Officer below Exh.4.

3. Heard Learned advocate for the applicant and learned Addl. PP Shri. Talegaonkar for the State.

4. The case of prosecution is that incident occurred on 19.01.2025 at about 09.30 p.m. Co-accused Sushant Ghadge and other persons present with him assaulted informant by fist and kick blows. Thereafter, co-accused Sushant Ghadge stabbed a knife to informant.

5. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that investigation is over and chargesheet has been filed against the accused. The applicant was not aware of filing of chargesheet. As per FIR the role of application is limited to the extent of beating informant by fist and kick blows. The FIR does not name the applicant. Major allegations are against co-accused against whom chargesheet is already filed. Therefore, applicant be released on bail.

6. The Ld. APP strongly opposed for grant of bail stating that applicant has participated in the offence and there is involvement of applicant. He may commit similar offence and may tamper with the witnesses, if released on bail.

7. Perused case papers, FIR is registered on 20.01.2025. The applicant had filed application for anticipatory bail bearing No.355/2025. The same was allowed. However, the applicant did not attend the police station and did not cooperate the investigation. The I.O. arrested main accused and filed

chargesheet against the applicant for the offence punishable under section 335 of B.N.S. It appears that Learned J.M.F.C. issued N.B.W. against the applicant on 26.08.2025. Thereafter, the applicant is arrested on 29.05.2026. Major allegation in the FIR is against co-accused and chargesheet is filed. Hence, the order.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The applicant **Siddharth S/o. Milind Jadhav** be released on his executing P.R. and S.B. of **Rs.15,000/-** with one solvent surety in the like amount, on following conditions :-
 - a) The applicant shall not tamper the prosecution evidence and witnesses.
 - b) The applicant shall attend the trial regularly unless exempted.
 - c) The applicant shall not commit similar or any other offence.
3. Bail before JMFC.
