The applicant has filed present application for releasing him on bail in connection with Crime No.502 of 2025, registered with Bhagyanagar Police Station, for the offences under Sections 310(2), 126(2), 115(2) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, (in short 'BNS').

2. Perused application and reply of Investigating Officer below Exh. 05.

3. Heard Learned advocate for the applicant and learned Addl. PP for the State.

4. The case against the applicant is that applicant and co-accused have wrongfully restrained the informant. They robbed an amount of Rs. 5,500/- from the informant and assaulted him by fist and kick blows.

5. Ld. Advocate for applicant submits that the co-accused are released on bail. Therefore, applicant is entitled for bail on the ground of parity.

6. The Ld. APP strongly opposed for grant of bail stating that the offence is serious. The applicant was absconding. He may commit similar offence and may tamper with the witnesses, if released on bail.

7. Perused case papers. The incident is dated 12-09-2025. Co-accused were arrested on 14-02-2026, whereas the applicant is arrested on 02-06-2026. It is seen that co-accused Vishal and Buddhabhushan are released on regular bail by order dated 17-04-2026 and 18-03-2026 respectively. The allegations against the present applicant are the same as of co-accused who are released on bail. It appears that material investigation is over. Therefore, the applicant is entitled for bail on the ground of parity. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. Applicant **Akshay s/o Keshav Pandhare** be released on his executing P.R. Bond of **Rs.30,000/-** with one solvent surety in the like amount, on following conditions :-
 - a) Applicant shall not tamper the prosecution evidence and witnesses.
 - b) Applicant shall attend the trial regularly unless exempted.
 - c) Applicant shall not commit similar or any other offence.
3. Bail before JMFC.
