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ORDER BELOW EXH. 05

Appellant husband has challenged the order passed by learned J.M.F.C. Kinwat Court No. 2 dated 17-11-2025 in PWDVA NO. 30/2022. The learned J.M.F.C. has granted monthly maintenance of Rs.15,000/- per month, compensation of Rs. 1,00,000/- and cost of Rs.2,000/-.

2. Mr. Baswante, learned advocate for the appellant husband submits that the husband has challenged the impugned order before this court. It will take considerable time to dispose of the appeal on merit. He submits that learned Trial Court has issued notice with respect to execution of impugned judgment and order. He submits that appellant has every hope to succeed in the appeal and therefore the execution proceeding No. 7/2025 be stayed during pendency of appeal.

3. The respondent wife though served has not caused appearance.

4. I have gone through impugned judgment and order. The appellant is working on the post of Senior Clerk in Treasury Office, Nanded; whereas respondent wife seems to be jobless. Learned Trial Court has considered all these aspects while passing impugned judgment.

5. On the query of this court, learned advocate for the appellant has filed pursis Exh. 09 and thereby informed this court that an amount of Rs.6,85,000/- is outstanding towards maintenance of respondent wife. Without going into the merits of the matter and considering the need of respondent wife, I find it would be just and proper to stay the execution of impugned judgment and order subject to appellant depositing 50% of outstanding amount which comes to approximately Rs.3,42,500/-. Appellant shall continue to deposit 50 % of monthly maintenance i.e. Rs.7,500/- per month during pendency of the appeal. Hence, the order -

ORDER

1. The judgment and order passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class (2nd Court) Kinwat in PWDVA No. 30/2022 is hereby stayed subject to appellant depositing 50% of the outstanding amount i.e. approximately Rs.,342,500/- within two weeks from the date of this order
2. The appellant to deposit monthly maintenance of Rs.7,500/- before this court on 10th day of each month. Two consecutive lapse on part of applicant will entail in cancellation of stay order.
3. The application Exh. 05 stands disposed of accordingly.
