ORDER BELOW EXH.69 IN SESSIONS CASE NO.249/2023

The State of Maharashtra Vs. Amol Marotrao Shinde (UTP)

This an application on behalf of original complainant with prayer to stay the operation of order passed below Exh.56 on 31/12/2025 as original complainant is going to challenge said order before Hon'ble High Court. Application is supported by affidavit of original complainant-Vishal Uttamrao Shinde.

2] By filing say below Exh.71, accused No.1 Amol Marotrao Shinde strongly opposed the application with submission that, whatever the order on bail application Exh.56 has been passed by giving fair opportunities to both parties. Therefore, merely the said order is to be challenged before Hon'ble High Court, it cannot be stayed in absence of any specific provision to that effect.

3] Heard both. Admittedly, bail application Exh.56 has been allowed by this Court after considering the argument put forth on behalf of both parties. There is no enabling provision under Code of Criminal Procedure to stay the order under reference. Therefore, I find no merits in present application, hence the following order:-
