The application is moved by the applicants under section 125 of the Criminal Procedure Code for the grant of interim monetary relief in the form of maintenance.

02. Perused the application and say. Heard learned advocate for the applicants Shri.M.P. Kulkarni and advocate for the non-applicant Shri. M. M. Arlikar. Perused the application supported with affidavit of the applicants. The affidavit of applicants prima-facie shows that, non-applicant has neglected to applicant no.1 to 3 and they are residing at the parental house of the applicant no.1. It is prima-facie seen that, non-applicant committed domestic violence against applicant no.1 to 3 and drove applicant no.1 to 3 away from his house.

03. The affidavit of applicant no.1 further reveals that, the non-applicant being a husband, it is his moral and legal duty to maintain his wife and childrens. The non-applicant is having good health. It is seen that, non-applicant has neglected to maintain his wife and childrens that is applicant no.1 to 3. The applicant no.1 has stated that she is unable to maintain herself and to her children. The non-applicant is having sufficient means of earning.

04. Considering the basic needs of applicant no.1 to 3 and the liability of the non-applicant it is necessary to hold him responsible for

maintenance of applicant no.1 to 3. Matter yet to be decided on merit. However, at this stage before evidence from bothsides, some amount in the form of interim maintenance needs to be awarded. I therefore, proceed to pass the following order:-

ORDER

1. Application is partly allowed.
2. Non-applicant is directed to pay interim maintenance of Rs.1500/- per month each, to applicant no.1 to 3 each from the date of filing this application, till final disposal of the main application.
3. Copy of this order be provided to the applicants, free of cost.
