ORDER BELOW EXH-01
(Passed on 24/04/2026)

- 1) The applicants have preferred present application for grant of heirship certificate.
- 2) It is case of the applicants that applicant no.1 is widow, applicant no.2 to 4 are daughters of the deceased **Digambar S/o. Mashnaji Bhure**, who died on **19/04/2025** leaving behind the applicants as his legal heirs. There is no legal heirs except the applicants. The deceased have not executed any will deed during his life time. The applicants required the heirship certificate for official purpose, therefore, the applicants prayed for issuing the heirship certificate.
- 3) A public notice was issued in daily news paper “Dainik Dalitwani” dated 20/02/2026, for calling objections from the public against claim of the applicants. Nobody appeared and resisted claim of the applicants.
- 4) The applicant filed documents i.e. verified copy of death certificate at Exh.16 which reveals that **Digambar S/o. Mashnaji Bhure** died on **19/04/2025**, verified copy of Aadhar card of deceased **Digambar** at Exh.17, copy of heirship certificate issued by Sarpanch village of Hanegaon Tq. Degloor at Exh.18, verified copies of Aadhar card of applicant no.1 to 4 at Exh.19 to 22.
- 5) Applicant no.1) **Gangamani W/o. Digambar Bhure** has examined herself on evidence affidavit at Exh.15 and closed the evidence vide pursis at Exh.23.

6) The claim of the applicants for grant of heirship Certificate has gone unchallenged, as nobody appeared to contest the present application. From the evidence of the applicants, it reveals that applicants are the legal heirs of deceased **Digambar S/o. Mashnaji Bhure** and beside the applicants, there is no legal heirs to deceased **Digambar S/o. Mashnaji Bhure**. Therefore, I have no hesitation to grant heirship certificate in favour of the applicants. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order :

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) Applicant no.1) **Gangamani W/o. Digambar Bhure**, 2) **Ambika W/o. Narayan Rajeboinwad**, 3) **Renuka W/o. Suresh Naikwade** and 4) **Aavantika D/o. Digambar Bhure** are declared to be heirs of deceased **Digambar S/o. Mashnaji Bhure**. Accordingly, issue heirship Certificate in prescribed form B in favour of the applicants on payment of required Court-fees.
- 3) The note under paragraph No.312 of Civil Manual, should invariably be appended to the certificate.
- 4) The applicants shall compliance of Paragraph No. 312 of Civil Manual within 6 months from receiving the heirship certificate. Other wise as paragraph No.313 of Civil Manual they will be liable to punishment under section 211 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
