Perused the record of the case and Roznama. The suit is instituted for perpetual injunction. The matter has been pending for steps of plaintiffs since long. However, plaintiffs failed to take steps, inspite of having sufficient opportunity. It also appears that since long neither plaintiffs nor their advocate present before the court. Resultantly, on 12/02/2026 the case was kept for dismissal in default order. In spite of that plaintiffs failed to appear and take the necessary steps.

02. Since last three dates matter has been kept for DID but neither plaintiffs nor their counsel present before the court. Today also, plaintiffs and their counsel are absent when called out repeatedly. No application is on record. It seen that plaintiffs have lost their interest in the proceeding of the suit. Therefore, I do not
