Samita & Ors Vs. L.I.C., Br. Degloor



ORDER BELOW EXH-01

(Passed on 18/03/2026)

01. The present application is preferred by the applicants for grant of Succession Certificate to withdraw the amount which is standing in the name of deceased **Gangadhar S/o. Ganpat Menure**.

02. It is case of the applicants that applicant no.1 is wife, applicant no. 2 to 4 are daughters and applicant no.5 is mother of deceased **Gangadhar S/o. Ganpat Menure** who died on **22.08.2025** leaving behind the applicants as his legal heirs. Except applicants, there is no legal heirs to the deceased. The deceased has not executed any will deed in respect of LIC Policy.

Lastly, the applicants prayed for issuing grant of Succession Certificate.

03. A public notice was issued in daily news paper “Dainik Ekmat” dated 17/12/2025 at Exh.15, for calling objections from the public against claim of the applicant, but nobody appeared and resisted the claim of the applicant. The non-applicant LIC company

was served with the notice. L.I.C., India Branch Degloor filed their say at Exh.16 and requested to pass appropriate order.

04. The applicant filed documents i.e. verified copy of death certificate at Exh.18 which reveals that the **Gangadhar S/o. Ganpat Menure** died on **22.08.2025**, copy of heirship certificate issued by Sarpanch village of Ballur Tq. Degloor at Exh.20, verified copy of LIC policy Bond at Exh.19, verified copy of Aadhar card of applicant no.1 to 5 at Exh.21 to 25.

05. On perusal of the documents and contents of applicants on affidavit, it reveals that total amount of **Rs.1,50,000/-** is pending in name of deceased **Gangadhar S/o. Ganpat Menure** in LIC Office, Branch at Degloor. Applicant No.1) **Samita Gangadhar Menure** has examined herself on evidence affidavit at Exh.17 and closed the evidence vide pursis at Exh.26.

06. From the record of case and it reveals that applicants are the legal heirs of deceased **Gangadhar S/o. Ganpat Menure**. Therefore, for the above stated all reasons, it proved that the deceased **Gangadhar S/o. Ganpat Menure** died leaving behind the applicants as his legal heirs and his above stated balance amount is lying in the LIC Office, branch at Degloor. Therefore, I have no hesitation to grant succession certificate in favour of the applicants. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order:

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) Issue Succession Certificate in favour of the applicant no.1) **Samita W/o. Gangadhar Menure**, 2) **Shravani D/o. Gangadhar Menure**, 3) **Shivani D/o. Gangadhar Menure**, 4) **Swaragini D/o. Gangadhar Menure** and 5) **Sarubai W/o. Ganpat Menure** on payment of required Court-fees for the purpose of withdraw the amount of **Rs.1,50,000/-** pending in LIC policy No.988338568 of LIC Branch Degloor Tq. Degloor Dist. Nanded along with interest, if any.
