ORDER BELOW EXH-01

01. The present application is preferred by the applicant for grant of Succession Certificate to withdraw the amount which is standing in the name of deceased **Dhondiba Gundareddy Madde**.

02. It is case of the applicant that she is widow of deceased **Dhondiba Gundareddy Madde**, who died on **10/08/2024** leaving behind the applicant as his legal heir. Except applicant, there is no legal heir to the deceased. The deceased has not executed any will deed in respect of the amount lying in his bank account. An amount of **Rs.38,046.03/-** of the deceased is lying in Bank A/c. No.**108411002000460** of The Nanded Dist. Central Co-op. Bank Ltd. Nanded, Branch Markhel, Tq. Degloor Dist. Nanded. Lastly, the applicant prayed for issuing grant of Succession Certificate.

03. A public notice was issued in daily news paper "**Dainik Dalitwani**" dated 20/01/2026 at Exh.(12), for calling objections from the public against claim of the applicant, but nobody appeared and resisted the claim of the applicant. The respondent bank was served with the notice but inspite of service of notice failed to appear and therefore, the application proceeded ex-parte against respondent.

04. The applicants filed documents i.e. verified copy of death certificate at Exh.14, which reveals that the deceased **Dhondiba Gundareddy Madde** died on **10/08/2024**, verified copy of Aadhar card of deceased **Dhondiba** at Exh.15, verified copy of First Page and last page of Bank Passbook of deceased Dhondiba at Exh.16,

copy of heirship certificate issued by Sarpanch village of Davangir Tq. Degloor at Exh.17, verified copy of Aadhar card of applicant at Exh.18.

05. On perusal of the documents and contents of applicant on affidavit, it reveals that an amount of **Rs.38,046.03/-** is lying in name of deceased **Dhondiba Gundareddy Madde** in The Nanded Dist. Central Co-op. Bank Ltd. Nanded, Branch Markhel, Tq. Degloor Dist. Nanded. Applicant has examined herself on evidence affidavit at Exh.13 and closed the evidence vide pursis at Exh.19.

06. The claim of the applicant for grant of Succession Certificate has gone unchallenged, as nobody contested the present application. Therefore, for the above stated all reasons, it proved that the deceased **Dhondiba Gundareddy Madde** died living behind the applicant as his legal heir and his above stated balance amount is lying in The Nanded Dist. Central Co-op. Bank Ltd. Nanded, Branch Markhel, Tq. Degloor Dist. Nanded. Therefore, I have no hesitation to grant succession certificate in favour of the applicant. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order:

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) Issue Succession Certificate in favour of the applicant namely **Vijaymala W/o. Dhondiba Made** on payment of required Court-fees for the purpose of withdraw the amount **Rs.38,046.03/-** lying in Bank A/c. No.108411002000460 of The Nanded Dist. Central Co-op. Bank Ltd. Nanded, Branch Markhel, Tq. Degloor Dist. Nanded along with interest, if any.
