ORDER BELOW EXH-1**(Date 30-03-2026)**

1) The applicants filed the instant application for grant of Heir-ship Certificate under The Bombay Regulation Act, 1827. The applicants submitted that, applicants are the legal heirs of deceased Gurewar Balamani Gangaram. He died on 16.10.2025. They need heir-ship certificate for mutation entries. Therefore, applicants have filed present application for heir-ship certificate.

2) After perusal of documents, it appears that, the Applicant No.1 is son, Applicant No.2 is daughter-in-law of deceased Gurewar Balamani Gangaram and wife of deceased Anil Gangaram Gurewar who is died on 02.02.2020, Applicant no.3 and 4 are grandson and granddaughter of deceased Gurewar Balamani Gangaram and daughter and son of deceased Anil Gangaram Gurewar, Applicant no.5 is daughter-in-law of deceased Gurewar Balamani Gangaram and wife of deceased Rajesh Gangaram Gurewar who is died on 02.11.2016 and Applicant no.6 and 7 are granddaughter of deceased Gurewar Balamani Gangaram and daughters of Rajesh Gangaram Gurewar. Husband of deceased Gurewar Balamani Gangaram namely deceased Gangaram Malayya Gurewar is died on 18.05.2010.

3) After filing of this application, notice was published in the daily newspaper 'Gaonwala' on 23/01/2026 calling objection. But, no objection

is raised to this application within stipulated period. The applicants filed on record the verified copy of death certificate of deceased Gurewar Balamani Gangaram, verified copy of death certificate of deceased Gangaram Malayya Gurewar, verified copy of death certificate of deceased Anil Gangaram Gurewar, verified copy of death certificate of deceased Rajesh Gangaram Gurewar, verified copy of ration card and copy of Tax receipt and copies of their Aadhar Cards.

4) Applicant No.1 filed affidavits in lieu of examination in chief at Exh.7 and asserted the same facts as application. Applicants also submit an affidavit of Narayan Poshatti Potrolu at Exh.09 & Khan Arbaz Mustafa at Exh.10 they are known applicants very well as only legal heirs of deceased.

5) Considering the oral evidence and documents on record, it appears that, applicants are legal heirs of deceased Gurewar Balamani Gangaram. Hence, application needs to be allowed. In the above facts and circumstances I proceed to pass following order:-

ORDER

1. The application is hereby allowed.
2. Heir-ship Certificate be issued in favour of applicants

- 1 Gurewar Sanjeev Gangaram,
- 2 Gurewar Gangamani Anil,
- 3 Meghraj Anil Gurewar,
4. Trishlata Anil Gurewar,
5. Gurewar Laxmi Rajesh,
6. Gurewar Trinandini Rajesh,
7. Gurewar Navyasri Rajesh.

are legal heirs of deceased Gurewar Balamani Gangaram in Appendix 'B'.

3. The applicants are directed to pay necessary Court Fee.
4. The note be appended to the heir-ship certificate as per para 312 of the Civil Manual.
5. This certificate neither confers right to the property nor finally determine or injure the rights of any person.
