Order

1. On perusal of the order-sheet, it appears that summons was issued against accused Upendra Sahni on 06.06.2007. Subsequently, on 16.11.2011, the accused appeared before the Court and was enlarged on bail. Thus, it is evident that he had full knowledge of the pendency of the present case.
2. Thereafter, the accused remained absent for a prolonged period and failed to appear before the Court despite having knowledge of the proceedings. Consequently, vide order dated 11.04.2018, his bail bond was cancelled.
3. Subsequently, N.B.W was issued against the accused on 09.08.2024. The execution report received on 30.09.2024 reveals that the accused was not available at his residence and was absconding. Thereafter, proclamation under section 82 Cr.p.c. (now corresponding provision of BNSS, if applicable) was issued. The execution report dated 24.10.2024 discloses that the proclamation was duly executed and affixed at the house of the accused. Even thereafter, the accused failed to appear before the Court within the prescribed period.
4. Thereafter, vide order dated 10.12.2025, process under section 83 Cr.p.c. was directed to be issued and the same was issued on 08.01.2026. Despite issuance and execution of coercive processes, the accused has neither appeared before the Court.
5. From the materials available on record, this court is satisfied that accused Upendra Sahni is deliberately concealing himself and has absconded

to avoid execution of warrants and to evade the due process of law. All reasonable coercive measures available under law have been exhausted without success.

6. Accordingly, accused Upendra Sahni is hereby declared a **Permanent Absconder (P.A.)** for the purpose of record and further proceedings. Let the record be consigned to the Permanent Absconder Register/Record Room, subject to revival immediately upon the arrest or surrender of the accused.

7. Office clerk is directed to issue permanent warrant against the accused Upendra Sahni and the same be forwarded to concerned police station for execution.
