

ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN OMCA NO.63/2016.

- 01- This is an application vide section 13 of The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969.
- 02- It is the contention of the applicant that her date of birth is 02-10-1965. But it is not recorded with the respondent. Hence, prayed for directions to the respondent.
- 03- The respondent has failed to appear and file say, hence application proceed ex-parte against it.
- 04- Perusal of record shows that the applicant has filed the Certificate in respect of non availability of the registration of birth, Age certificate. The applicant has examined herself on oath.
- 05- The applicant has deposed on oath in consonance with the contents in the application. Though, it appears that the specific date of birth is not mentioned in the age certificate, but as the applicant is illiterate person and as per the submission of the learned advocate for applicant, no other document is available to show exact date of birth, the birth date of the applicant can be considered to be true on the basis of her oral evidence. Therefore, considering the evidence on oath and documents on record. It is just and proper to direct the respondent to take the entry of the date of birth of applicant. Accordingly, following order.

ORDER

- 1- Application is allowed.
- 2- The respondent is directed to take entry in respect of date of birth of applicant namely Shivnanda to be 02-10-1965 as observed above.
- 3- Inform accordingly to the respondent.
