ORDER BELOW EXH.165

1. Read application and say filed by Ld. APP.
2. Heard learned Adv. C. M. Rathod for accused as well as learned APP. Shri. Vasant Chavan for State.
3. This is an application moved on behalf of accused No.27 Firoz Kadar Dosani for permission to direct passport authority for issuance of passport. According to him, he is permanent resident of Mahur Dist. Nanded. An offence punishable under Section 465, 468, 471 r/w. 34 of the Indian Penal Code came to be registered at Police Station, Mahur vide crime No.37/2018. After completion of investigation chargesheet came to be filed in this court and case registered as RCC 61/2020.
4. Accused No.27 Firoz Dosani wants to go to Saudi Arabia for religious purpose. Therefore, he requires renewal of the passport. He requires no objection certificate from the Court to obtain passport as matter is pending against him. Therefore, he filed an application for no objection for renewal/issuance of passport.
4. The Ld. APP filed say behind this application and

objected to allow application on the ground that trial will be protracted.

5. Investigation Officer/Incharge of Mahur Police Station has filed say vide Exh.169 and given no objection to renewal/issuance of passport.

6. On perusal of charge-sheet it appears that investigation officer filed charge-sheet against accused for the offence punishable under Sections 465, 468, 471 r/w. 34 of the Indian Penal Code. Trial is commenced and prosecution has examined 16 witnesses. Accused No.27 is permanent resident of Mahur Dist. Nanded. If he is not permitted for issuance/renewal of passport, he will suffer irreparable loss. No harm will be caused to the prosecution side if Court given no objection for issuance/renewal of passport. He is ready to abide all conditions imposed by the Court.

7. The applicant moved application for renewal/issuance of passport. He at liberty to make fresh application for permission to depart from the India when actually needed. Prayer regarding renewal/issuance of passport needs to be allowed. Considering the submission, it will just and proper to give no objection for renewal/ issuance of passport for period of 10 years or 20 years as per the Passport Rules to him. Thus, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.

2. This Court has 'No objection' for renewal/issuance of passport for 10 years or 20 years as the case may be to applicant/accused No.27 Firoz Kadar Dosani R/o. Mahur Tal. Mahur Dist. Nanded as per Passport Rules in connection with R.C.C. No.61/2020, C.R. No.37/2018 registered with Police Station, Mahur.
3. The Passport authority may issue/renew passport of the applicant for the above mention period. If applicant entitled for the same accordance with the law on furnish necessary compliance.
