**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

1] It is an application for issuance of heirship certificate vide section 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act, VIII of 1827. It is alleged that, father of applicant namely Maroti s/o Iraba parit @ Ibitadar demise on dated 15.06.1982. Applicant is heir thereof. He need heirship certificate in that regard.

2] Evidence of applicant came to be adduced on the part of the applicant vide Exh.11. He re-irritated averments of the application. Apart from oral evidence applicants relied upon death certificate of deceased Maroti s/o Iraba parit @ Ibitadar (Exh.12) and Aadhar identity card of applicant has also been relied upon. Death certificate on record endorse that, deceased Maroti s/o Iraba parit @ Ibitadar demise on dated 15.06.1982. Wife and mother of deceased are already demised.

3] Public citation notice (Exh.10) came to be published in videly circulated daily news paper. However nobody came forward to object claim of applicant. Application is supported by affidavit. At present juncture, there is nothing on record to disbelieve contentions of the applicant. Hence following order -
