1] Accused prosecuted for offence punishable under section 65 (E) of Bombay Prohibition Act. Presence of accused not secure despite repeated summons and NBW's. As such I found it a fit case to stop the proceeding vide section 281 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita. Prosecution is reluctant to secure presence of accused. Such reluctants resulted into ingerering the matter. It seems that, there is no likelihood of presence of accused being secure in near future. As such, it is fit case to stop the proceeding. - 1] Proceeding against accused thereby stop and he is discharge vide section 281 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita.
- 2] Bail bonds of accused stands canceled.
- 3] Seized 52 liter illicit liquor be destroyed after appeal period is over.
