ORDER BELOW EXH 1 IN OMCA No. 43/2026
(Ashraf Vs. State)

1. Perused the application and say filed by the learned A.P.P. The investigating officer of Ramtirth Police Station did not filed say. Hence, no say order was passed against him.
2. This application has been filed by the applicant for custody of Mahindra & Mahindra Limited XUV 500 bearing Chassis No. **MA1YL2HJUC6A71816** it's Engine No. **HJC4A15003**, bearing RTO Registration No. **MH-46-P-8481**, seized in Crime No. 10/2026 of P.S. Ramtirth. The owner of said car is Vijay Ramakant Sonawane. The Vijay Ramakant Sonawane on 10/12/2025 sold out the said car to Asharaf Shakil Shaikh. The copy of sale deed, R. C. book of said car, copy of FIR and copy of Adhar cards of applicant have been produced on record. The owner of vehicle Vijay Sonwane below Exh. 2/1 has filed affidavit that he has no objection to give the vehicle in possession of applicant, as he has sold it to applicant. After verifying the said documents it appears that, the applicant' is the original owner of said car.
3. In order to prevent the said car being damaged in the police station by lying there without use, in my opinion, the temporary custody of the said car can be given to the applicant on certain conditions. Considering all these aspects, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The Mahindra & Mahindra Limited XUV 500 bearing Chassis No. **MA1YL2HJUC6A71816** it's Engine No. **HJC4A15003**, bearing RTO Registration No. **MH-46-P-8481**, seized in Crime No. 10/2026 of P.S. Ramtirth. be handed over to **Asharf Shakil Shaikh** on executing bond of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Three Lakh Rupees.)
2. The car be handed over to the applicant by preparing Panchanama to the effect, in the presence of the two panchas, taking photographs of the car at the time of handing over its possession to the applicant.
3. The applicant shall execute a bond before I.O. to the effect that he shall produce the car when directed by the Court and he shall be bound by all further orders of the Court with respect to the said car that may be passed according to the law. He shall not alienate the car or change its nature so as to change its identity until orders of the Court.
4. The applicant shall not use the car in commission of any offence.
5. Issue letter to concerned police station accordingly.
