Sangita Vs. Sulochanabai & Ors.

1. The plaintiff has filed present application to grant the Status Quo.
2. It is the contention of plaintiff that, the defendant are intentionally not filing the say and written statement. The defendant are threatening to alienate the suit properties. If the defendants will succeed then the irreparable loss would be caused to the plaintiff. The suit properties are purchased from joint family income and therefore the plaintiff is having right and share in the suit properties. Hence, till then it is necessary to grant Status Quo. Hence, the application be allowed.
3. Per contra the defendants have only objected the application.
4. The Temporary Injunction application is supported by the affidavit and on the same basis the present application for Status Quo is filed by the plaintiff. Perused the documents filed by the plaintiff it appears that the suit properties are in the names of defendants. While it is the contention of the plaintiff that the suit properties are purchased from joint family income and therefore she is having share in it. Perused the record it appears that the defendant No. 1 to 3, 7 & 8

appeared before the court, but did not file their written statement. Hence no written statement order is passed against them. While, the defendants without mentioning their say in detail only objected the application. Prima facie it appears that, the suit properties are in the name of defendants and if they alienate the suit properties then the irreparable loss would be caused to the plaintiff. Hence, it is necessary to grant the Status Quo. If the Status Quo is granted then no irreparable loss would be caused to the defendants. Therefore in the interest of justice I pass the following order.

ORDER

Both the parties to maintain Status Quo till next date.
