On perusal of the file, it reveals that proclamation warrants under Section 82 Cr.P.C. issued against accused received back duly executed on 15.12.2022. Statement of Serving Constable ASI Daljeet Kumar 706/R, Summons Staff, Rupnagar recorded regarding due proclamation but accused has not come present. From the aforementioned statement of Executing Constable, this Court is satisfied that proclamation has been duly executed as per provisions contained in Section 82 Cr.P.C. Mandatory period of 30 days has already been lapsed since publication of proclamation on 15.12.2022 but accused has not come present.

As such, accused **Baljinder Singh Saini** is hereby declared as '**Proclaimed Person**' in the present case. Intimation be sent to concerned SHO for constituting a special team for apprehending the accused and proceeding against him.

No CW is present today and adjournment for the same is requested. At request of counsel for the complainant, case stands adjourned to **10.03.2023** for complainant evidence under Section 299 of the CrPC.

Report of concerned Tehsildar/Deputy Commissioner and concerned SHO qua movable and immovable property of accused be also called for the date fixed.
