Previously notice u/s 223 BNSS was issued subject to filing of PF. However, as per the dictum of the Hon'ble Supreme court of India in CRIMINAL APPEAL NO. 1755 OF 2010 SANJABIJ TARI Vs. KISHORE S. BORCAR & ANR, there is no need to issued notice u/s 223 BNSS at pre-cognizance stage. Therefore, placing reliance on the above-mentioned judgement, the court shall proceed further with the matter.

Counsel for the complainant filed an application for condonation of delay as there is delay in filing of the present matter.

Complainant is directed to place on record spare copy of complaint.

Let notice be issued to the proposed accused, on filing of PF, to file reply of the same along with spare copy of the complaint on NDOH . PF be filed within 7 working days.
