1. This is an injury compensation claim filed under **Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988**. The parties appeared before the Mediator, and during the process of mediation, they have amicably settled their dispute. There is a **full and final settlement** in this matter. The compromise petition/document is marked as **Exhibit No.17**. It has been verified in the presence of the parties in Court, and the parties have been identified by their respective advocates.

2. Following the compromise, **the following AWARD is passed.**

AWARD

1. Non-applicant No.2, TATA AIG General Insurance Co. Ltd., shall pay **Rs. Five Lakh Fifty Thousand only (Rs. 5,50,000/-)** as full and final settlement in respect of the entire awarded amount. This shall constitute the **full and final settlement of the claim.**

2. The awarded compensation amount shall be paid **within 30 days** under **Section 168(3)** of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. In case of default, the petitioner shall be entitled to interest at the rate of **9% per annum** on the decretal amount from the date of Award until full realization.

3. The awarded amount along with accrued interest shall be deposited in the bank account of Court with following details : **Member, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Nagpur i.e. Account No. 40799142551, IFSC Code - SBIN0051191** of State Bank of India, Branch Akashwani Chowk, Poonam Plaza, Civil Lines, Nagpur by NEFT/RTGS only.

4. The parties shall bear their respective costs.
5. As the matter has been **settled before mediation**, the **court fees shall be fully refunded to the petitioner**.
6. The parties are required to take back their original documents in accordance with Paragraphs 524 to 528 of the **Bombay High Court Civil Manual**. Failing which, the documents may be destroyed after the prescribed time frame.
7. This Award shall be uploaded on the Court's **CIS system** within three working days from the date of signing.
8. Bill of costs shall follow the Award.
