

Witness is now shown her affidavit of examination-in-chief. She identified her signature and the contents of documents. She has also filed certified copy of Form AA, FIR, spot panchnama, inquest panchanama, postmortem report, certificate of registration of Bus bearing registration No. MH-12AU-9408. All these documents are certified copy and provided by Police Station. Hence, they are exhibited. They are at Exhs.30 to 35. Photocopy of school leaving certificate attested by learned advocate Mr. Asole, same is not disputed by other parties. Hence, it is exhibited. It is at **Exh. 36**. Claimants have filed her aadhar card. It is at **Exh.36/1 to 36/3**.

**Cross examination for Respondent No. 1 (MSRTC) by advocate Mr. Milind Bhongade**

2) Accident occurred on 18/05/2005. I learnt it from some people. I have not witnessed the accident. My husband was working as driver in MSRTC. On that day, he was on duty on ST. Bus No. MH-12-AU-9408, which was being plied between Nagpur – Pune- Nagpur. There were two drivers in the bus. My husband was senior driver. Accident occurred on National Highway between Khamgaon to Balapur. At the relevant time, my husband was not on driving seat but he was in the cabin of the bus and other driver was on the wheels. There was head on collision between bus and the truck. I cannot say how accident occurred, because I have not witnessed the same.

3) We have received some compensation amount from the Labour Commissioner, Nagpur which was deposited by MSRTC. It was Rs. 3,79,120/-. We had received this amount in the year 2006-2007 but I am not exactly recollecting the date and month.

4) My daughter and son are prosecuting studies. Claimant Nos. 4 and 5 my mother and father in law respectively. They have died during the pendency of the petition.

5) I am now working in MSRTC as clerk. I have received appointment on compassionate ground in 2008. It is not true to say that I have already received compensation and this petition against MSRTC is not maintainable. It is not true to say that I am deposing false.

**Cross examination for Respondent No. 3 (United India Insurance Company Ltd.)-  
Absent when called repeatedly. It's 3:30. Hence, no cross.**
