By this application under Section 448 of the B.N.S.S. 2023, applicant – original accused has prayed for transfer of 3 Summary Criminal Cases filed by the non-applicant against him, for the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, to one court as all the 3 cases are pending in different courts.

2] The non-applicant contended that the applicant is trying to protract the cases.

3] The fact is not disputed that all the 3 cases are between the same parties, for the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. Adv. N.R. Bhandakkar for the non-applicant has admitted that all the 3 cases are arising out of dishonour of 3 cheques issued in same transaction. He submitted that if the cases are transferred, the same should be ordered to be expedited, as the non-applicant is senior citizen.

4] In view of Section 219 of Cr.P.C. and for general convenience and having regard to the above facts, application deserves to be allowed. In the result, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

[i] Application is allowed with no order as to costs.

[ii] S.C.C. No. 16780/2024, pending in the court of 28th Joint Civil Judge Senior Division and ACJM, Nagpur, and S.C.C. No. 16793/2024, pending in the court of 2nd ACJM, Nagpur, are ordered to be transferred to the court of 25th Joint Civil Judge Senior Division and ACJM, Nagpur, where S.C.C. No. 16777/2024 is pending for adjudication.

[iii] Attention of the learned trial court is invited to the Circular No. Rule/P-1615/91, dated 3rd August, 2009, issued by the Hon'ble High Court, to give priority to the cases of senior citizens.

[iv] The transferee court is directed to tag all the 3 cases in C.I.S. on administrative side, to avoid further split.
