1. The respondent No.1 filed complaint against the applicant and respondent Nos.3 and 4 under Section 499 and 500 of the Indian Penal Code. The applicant who is accused No.1 before the Trial Court challenged the order passed by 2nd Addl. C. J. M., Nagpur dated 19/03/2019 in Summary Case No.9498 of 2019 below Exh.1. During pendency of the revision respondent Nos.3 and 4 entered into compromise with respondent Nos. 1 and 2 before the Trial Court and settled the dispute. So the respondent Nos.3 and 4 filed this application who wants to delete their names from this case.
2. The respondent Nos.3 and 4 entered into compromise before the Trial Court and they compounded the offence and the present applicant challenged issuance of process against him. In such circumstances, the respondent Nos. 3 and 4 are not necessary party to revision and their presence in this case is not necessary. The applicant is not having any objection to delete their names. Hence, permission is to be given to delete names of the respondent Nos.3 and 4 from this case. Hence, proceed the following order.

2. Names of the Respondent Nos.3 and 4 be deleted from this revision.
