1] I am running a hospital under the name of '*Mehra Hospital*' situated at Civil Lines, Chandrapur. Patient named **Mr. Radheya Anil Parkhi** came to my hospital on 15.04.2022. The patient met with an (R.T.A.) accident on 14.04.2022 and then discharged on 29.04.2022.

2] The patient sustained injuries in the said accident and was admitted to the hospital, where he remained under indoor treatment for a period of approximately 14 days (about two weeks). During the course of hospitalization, he was treated with antibiotics and analgesics. Although there was a head injury, no neurosurgical intervention was required, and the condition was managed conservatively with medication.

3] The patient suffered fractures of the right-sided bones, namely the Clavicle, Scapula, and Humerus. These injuries are of a grievous nature. The fractures are duly supported by medical records, including X-ray reports and the discharge summary issued by the hospital.

4] The hospital documents, including indoor case papers and treatment records, indicate that the patient was kept under continuous

medical supervision and was provided necessary conservative as well as orthopedic management for the said fractures.

5] Original Discharge Summary is now shown to me, its contents are true and correct, it bears my signature and seal of my hospital. It is already marked as Exh.29.

6] It takes four to six weeks for these fractures to unite. Once the patient recovers he can perform his ordinary daily activities. It is true to say that, the healing capacity of young is better than the older one. It is true to say that, this patient was of ten years of age and relatively his recovery would have been faster. It is true to say that, this patient can attend the school and there will not be any kind of difficulty for studies. It is true to say that, the injuries would be healed and there will not be any kind of permanent disability. It is not true to say that, I am deposing falsely.
