On solemn affirmation I depose that

[Examination-in-Chief by Adv.Shri.PV.Gupta for Petitioner]-

1] I am working with Global City Hospital for last three years. The patient namely Nandkishor Bondre came to the hospital at around 11 a.m. on 12th May 2024. The patient had a history of a road traffic accident with another type of vehicle. He was driving a two-wheeler at Bhandevadi, Pardi, around 8 a.m. in the morning. The patient came to the hospital around 11 a.m. I saw the patient around 12:30 p.m., and after examining him, we stabilized the patient with intravenous fluids. Thereafter, there was a lacerated wound present on the right foot of the patient. So what we did was primary dressing there, and after getting fitness from the anesthetist and observing that the patient was healthy and stable for the next 4–6 hours, we proceeded for debridement and closed reduction of that foot. I took the patient to the OT around 5 p.m. on the same day, that is 12th May 2024. The lacerated wound was thoroughly debrided using Betadine, H₂O₂, and saline, and a K-wire was passed through the wound fracture site. Closed reduction was done from proximal to distal, and a below-knee plaster was applied to the patient to immobilize the

foot. After seeing the X-ray in the same arm, the patient was taken back to the recovery room.

2] Due to the collision, there was a fracture accounting for Grade 2B, and there was a lacerated wound. His finger, that is the little toe, the metatarsal was fractured; it was a comminuted fracture. We passed a K-wire through that, and fixation was done.

3] Regarding future life, there might be a possibility, but I do not think so, because the wound is now good and the fracture has subsided. There might be a small possibility of the knee getting involved with a little bit of uneasiness if the fracture has not united properly; otherwise, it was not that serious.
