2] I have not produced any document to show that monthly income of my husband deceased was 15000/-. It is not true to say that my husband was not working in Uber Eats. It is correct to say that FIR is not lodged on the date of accident 10.06.2019. My husband was admitted in Kalpataru Hospital on 10.06.2019. Kalpataru Hospital also did not informed about the accident of my husband to the police station. The witness voluntarily state that police did not register her complaint.

3] I did not informed this fact to my advocate. It is not true to say that accident did not take place on 10.06.2019 therefor, I did not informed my advocate.

4] My husband was discharged from Kalapataru Hospital on 11.06.2019 he was taken home after discharge. He was admitted in Kothari Hospital which is near our house on next date. He was admitted in Kothari Hospital for three to four days. He was operated for his leg injury in Kothari Hospital. After three to four days he was discharged from Kothari Hospital. I have not produced treatment expenditure bills of Kothari Hospital.

5] Police also did not come to Kothari Hospital. He was taken home after discharged from Kothari Hospital. Doctor from Kothari Hospital was giving treatment to my husband at home. I have not filed any treatment expenditure bill of the treatment which has given my husband at home.

6] Condition of my husband was stable after discharged of Kothari Hospital. My husband informed that he was having pain in chest. When we were taking him to the hospital he died on the way. It is not true to say that Maruti Car is not involved in the accident. It is not true to say that offending Maruti Swift Car bearing registration No. MH-36-H-8471 is not involved in the accident. I have not produced treatment expenditure bills of Rs.8,50,000/-.

7] It is not true to say that I have falsely implicated the offending Maruti Swift Car in the claim petition to recover the claim amount. It is not true to say that I have file false claim petition and I have produced false documents and I am deposing falsely.
