ORDER BELOW EXH.19

The Land of Decree Holder and his family members was acquired by the NIT. The Special Land Acquisition officer passed award and there was dispute about apportionment of the compensation reference under Section 30 of the Land Acquisition Act was made by the Collector to this Court. It was bearing LAR No.2 of 2004 After adjudication, it was decided that Decree Holder is entitled for getting entire compensation amount decided by the LAO. As per NIT after award was passed the amount of compensation was deposited with the Land Acquisition officer. The Special Land Acquisition Officer did not make payment to the Decree Holder, hence, he filed execution application before the Court. As amount is lying with the Collector and reference is made by the Collector / the Special Land Acquisition officer. Hence, they are necessary parties to the reference. Hence, they are joined as JD No.2 and 3. Issue notice to newly added JD No.2 and 3 to deposit the amount deposited by NIT in Court along with accrued interest thereon.
