ORDER BELOW EXH.1

(Passed on 1st January 2026)

Petitioner has filed the present petition for grant of compensation of Rs.10,00,000/- on account of injuries sustained by him in a vehicular accident. However as there was elements of settlement, therefore as per referral order Exh.29, matter was referred to Judge Mediator for mediation.

2] Accordingly both the parties appeared before Mediator and have settled their dispute amicably. Respondent No.2 agreed to pay compensation of Rs.1,25,000/- to petitioner towards full and final settlement. Petitioner agreed to accept the same. They also filed joint pursis Ex.30 on record to that effect. Similarly the Mediator has also filed success report of mediation vide Exh.31 and 32. Thus matter is settled at Rs.1,25,000/- towards full and final settlement, before the Mediator.

3] Therefore in view report of Mediator Exh.31 and 32 so also joint compromise pursis Exh.30 petition is allowed.

4) Respondent No.2 is hereby directed to transfer the amount of Rs.1,25,000/- into the Bank account of petitioner by NEFT/RTGS, details of which are furnished as under, on due verification and identification :

5] Respondent No.2 is hereby directed to re-verify the account details of the petitioner from the documents provided by him and on satisfaction of its correctness, then only transfer the awarded amount into the bank account of petitioner.

6] Award be drawn up accordingly by giving details of savings account of petitioner in it, as above.

7] Petition against respondent No.1 stands dismissed.

8] As matter is settled in mediation, therefore Court Fees according to law be refunded.
