1. Applicant Munsif Naseem Quereshi filed application for anticipatory bail u/s 482 of BNSS. He submitted that on wrong information police is calling for interrogation. In the say of anticipatory bail of co-accused police named applicant as an accused. He has no connection with the crime. He is praying for anticipatory bail and till say of police is received he be given ad-interim protection.
2. I heard, learned counsel for applicant and learned APP. On perusal of FIR name of the applicant is not appearing in it. There is mention of Mahindra Pick up vehicle and applicant is also having same vehicle. On this ground police is calling him for interrogation and police may arrest him. Prima facie, there appears no connection of the applicant with the crime. Hence, he is entitled for ad-interim protection till say

of the police is received. So, I proceed to pass following order.

**ORDER**

1. Ad-interim protection is given to accused till filing of say by the police.
2. In the event of arrest applicant Munsif Naseem Quereshi be released on bail on furnishing P R. bond of Rs. 25,000/- and one solvent surety in the like amount, on condition that -
  - a) He shall attend police station, Khaperkheda on every Friday between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. or whenever called by the I.O.
  - b) He shall not try to contact with witnesses and tamper with the evidence.
