**Order below Exhibit No.1**

The accused are absconding. There is no likelihood of accused being arrested in near future. The case is very old. Hence, it is decided to record statement of prosecution witnesses as per Section 299 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Hence, the order :-

**ORDER**

- 1] Issue witness summons to all the prosecution witnesses for recording their evidence in absence of accused vide empowerment of Section 299 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
- 2] Issue open (undated) non-bailable warrant against the accused. It shall remain pending with the police station till the accused are arrested.
- 3] Issue proclamation against the accused.
- 4] Issue notice to the surety of the accused to show cause as to why the surety bonds should not be forfeited and why the amount of surety bonds should not be recovered from them.
- 5] Issue notice to the accused to show cause as to why the Personal Recognition bonds should not be forfeited and why the amount of Personal Recognition bonds should not be recovered from them.
