**ORDER BELOW EXH.01**  
(Dtd. 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2026)

This matter is taken up on today's board in the Special Drive. This is a summons case instituted upon police report for the offence punishable under Section 285 of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita. The case is pending since 2025. Attempt is made to secure the presence of accused by issuing summons to him. From record, it can be seen that the prosecution failed to secure presence of the accused even after issuance of summons to him. There is no possibility of presence of the accused in near future. No fruitful purpose will be achieved by keeping this proceeding pending. Therefore, I am inclined to invoke the powers under Section 281 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita. Hence the following order.

**ORDER**

1. The proceeding is stopped vide Section 281 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita.
2. The accused is discharged as per provisions of Section 281 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita.
