**Order below Exh.01**

This is an application for release of seized Mobile handset under Section 503 of the BNSS.

**02.** Perused the application and the say of the I.O. and the Ld. APP. Say of accused is also called. Perused the FIR and the relevant seizure memo.

**03.** Mobile handset, model One Plus 12R (8/256) having IMEI No.869376070829092 is seized in connection with Crime No. 94/2025 for the offence punishable under Section 303(2) of BNS, 2023 registered by Ajni Police Station against the accused.

**04.** The I.O. and the learned APP have taken strong objection to release the said mobile in favour of the applicant. Accused in the present crime has also filed his reply vide **Exh.5** and given no objection to release the mobile in favour of the applicant.

**05.** The applicant has placed on record copies of her Adhar card, bill/loan summary of the said mobile and copy of FIR which are

sufficient to substantiate that she is owner of the seized mobile.

06. Considering the nature of the crime, no purpose would be served in retaining the said mobile handset unused and idle in the police station. The applicant has made out sufficient grounds for interim custody of the mobile handset. Hence, the following order;

**ORDER**

[i]	Application is allowed.
[ii]	The I.O. shall release the seized property i.e. Mobile handset, model One Plus 12R (8/256) having IMEI No.869376070829092, in favour of the applicant <b>Sarita Chandu Nade</b> , on executing indemnity bond for the amount of Rs.39,000/- (Rs.Rupees Thirty Nine Thousands only) on conditions that she shall not dispose-of or sell, gift, transfer, or change the nature of mobile handset in any manner till the final disposal of the case and she shall produce the said mobile handset as and when required by the Investigating Officer or by any Court which would be arisen out of Crime No.94/2025 of P.S. Ajni.
[iii]	The applicant to execute the indemnity bond before I.O.. The I.O. is directed to prepare detailed panchanama of seized mobile handset and also to take it's appropriate photographs before handing over the custody of the same to the applicant.
[iv]	This order be communicated to the I.O.
[v]	The indemnity bond be attached along with charge sheet.
