Manisha Vs. State of Maharashtra  
(PS Sitaburdi)

**ORDER BELOW EXH-1**  
(Passed on 25.03.2026)

1. This is an application filed by the applicant **Manisha Sugayya Kautalmath** to get interim custody of her two wheeler vehicle i.e. **Maestro Green Color, bearing registration No. MH-31-EJ-6452, Chasis No. MBLJF32ABDGH07193, Engine No.JF32AADGH06837**, seized in Crime No.27/2026, u/sec. 64(2)(m) and 69 of the BNS, 2023 registered in Sitabuldi Police Station.
2. Say of Ld. A.P P and I.O. were called out.
3. I have heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant and learned APP for the prosecution at the considerable length. I have gone through with the documents filed on record.
4. The applicant submitted that she is resident of Nagpur. She is the owner of said vehicle. The Advocate for the applicant further submitted that she is the only rightful claimant of the said vehicle.
5. The applicant has filed verified copy of her Aadhar Card, verified copy of RC Book, copy of Insurance Certificate and Copy of FIR. Prima-facie it appears that the above mentioned property lies in the name of present applicant. It is also important to note that no other person except the present applicant has claimed the said vehicle till today. Further, if the said property is not released then it may be caused damage and its condition may deteriorate. Under such circumstances, keeping the said vehicle with the police machinery would not serve any purpose.

6. Therefore, considering all these facts and documents available on record, in my view, the said property/vehicle can be released on imposing certain conditions. Resultantly, I proceed to pass following order.

**ORDER**

- 1 The application is allowed.
- 2 During inquiry & trial of the case arises out of Crime No.27/2026 of Police Station Sitabuldi, seized two wheeler vehicle i.e. **Maestro Green Color, bearing registration No. MH-31-EJ-6452, Chasis No. MBLJF32ABDGH07193, Engine No.JF32AADGH06837**, be returned to the applicant **Manisha Sugayya Kautalmath** on executing indemnity/Supratnama bond of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh only) on stamp paper.
- 3 The applicant is further directed not to alienate, sell, change or dispose of the seized property in any manner till final decision of above said crime of case and produce it as and when ordered or required by the court.
- 4 I. O. is directed to take two photograph of the aforesaid property and prepare the detail panchanama of vehicle prior to the handing over the property and shall file it along with charge sheet and inventory.
- 5 The applicant shall submit a bond duly executed by her before the Concerned Police Station.
- 6 Breach of any above condition, will liable for the cancellation of bond.
