This is an application for release of seized motorcycle under Section 503 of the BNSS.

**02.** Perused the application and the say of the I.O. and the Ld. APP. Perused the FIR and the relevant seizure memo.

**03.** Vehicle DIO bearing registration No. MH-49/AQ-2948 Chasis No.ME4JF39DDHU019105, Engine No. JF39EU2025887 is seized in connection with Crime No.556/2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 305(1), 331(4), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 registered by Ajni Police Station against the accused.

**04.** The applicant has claimed that he is the registered owner of the seized vehicle. The copy of the Registration Particulars duly substantiates said fact. The I.O. and the learned APP have taken strong objection to release the vehicle in favour of the applicant.

**05.** It is alleged by the prosecution that accused used the said vehicle for the offence of theft and house breaking. Admittedly, the applicant has no nexus with the alleged crime. Considering the

nature of the crime, no purpose would be served in retaining the said vehicle unused and idle in the police station. The applicant has made out sufficient grounds for interim custody of the vehicle. Hence, the following order;

**ORDER**

[i]	Application is allowed.
[ii]	The I.O. shall release the seized property i.e. DIO bearing registration No. MH-49/AQ-2948 Chasis No. ME4JF39DD HU019105, Engine No. JF39EU2025887 in favour of the applicant <b>Rajkumar Gyaniram Bhautik</b> , on executing indemnity bond for the amount of Rs.25,000/- (Rs.Twenty Five Thousands only) on conditions that he shall not dispose-of or sell, gift, transfer, or change the nature of vehicle in any manner till the final disposal of the case and he shall produce the said vehicle as and when required by the Investigating Officer or by any Court arising out of Crime No.556/2025 of P.S. Ajni.
[iii]	The applicant to execute the indemnity bond before I.O. The I.O. is directed to prepare detailed panchanama of seized vehicle and also to take it's appropriate photographs before handing over the custody of the same to the applicant.
[iv]	This order be communicated to the I.O.
[v]	The indemnity bond be attached along with charge sheet.
