



**: J U D G M E N T :

The contents of offences were read over and explained to the accused to which he pleaded guilty and admitted to the charges levelled against him. It was informed to the accused that he need not plead guilty under any pressure and if he pleads guilty, he may be sentenced accordingly. The accused still pleaded guilty, which according to me was voluntary, hence, the following order.


: O R D E R :

1. The accused **Rahul Dadarao Mane**, is hereby convicted vide section 275 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for the offence punishable U/sec.285 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and sentenced to pay fine of Rs.300/- (Rs.Three Hundred Only) and in default he is sentenced to suffer S.I. for 03 (Three) days.
2. For the offence punishable under section 223 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, a private complaint is necessary for taking cognizance. However, the same is registered on the basis of a police report. Therefore, considering the overall situation and the bar contemplated for the said section as regards taking cognizance, proceeding in respect of the said section i.e. 223 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita against accused is hereby dropped


and he is discharged for the offence punishable under section 223 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita
